

- Individual experts




Programme for ALL EU Member States

- Objective: Strengthen the capacity to implement reforms
- Legal base: Regulation (EU) 2017/825
- **Demand-driven**: upon request
- **Duration:** 2017-2020
- **Budget**: €142.8 million (2017-2020)
 - o no co-financing required
- Scope: a wide range of policy areas

2ND ROUND OF THE STRUCTURAL REFORM SUPPORT PROGRAMME (SRSP)

- 444 requests for support received for an estimated total amount of EUR 152 million
- 146 projects proposed to be funded under SRSP 2018 (from 24 Member States)

HOW IT WORKS

At the request of a Member State, the SRSS:

- Engages in a dialogue to discuss technical support needs;
- Provides financing for support and coordinates the necessary expertise.

The SRSS support is available to all EU Member States.
