

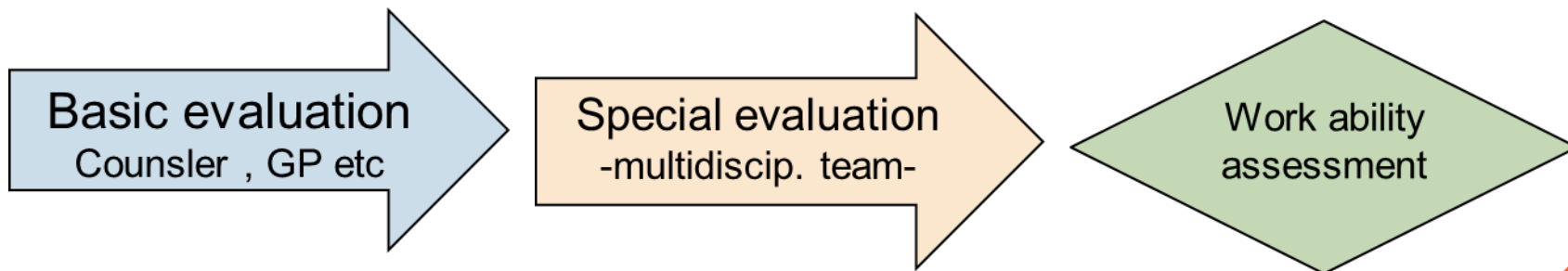

The work ability assessment

- Evaluation over time closely connected with Vocational rehabilitation
- Multidisciplinary approach at all points



- The aim is to work systematically with loss of function through vocational rehabilitation and at the same time empower abilities of the individual
- Information that are gathered through vocational rehabilitation are important for the work ability assessment, RTW and/or the disability assessment

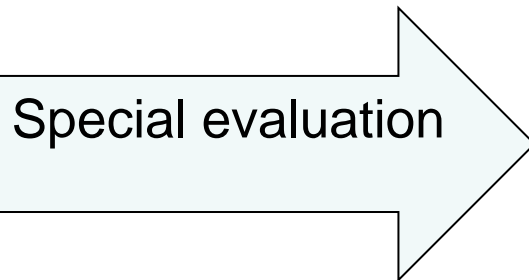
